Trip Details:

Season: 1st week of April, May & June & mid September to October.

The Location: Manali Hamta valley.

Trip Length: 6 Nights/7 Days. Distance: 593 Kms. from Delhi (one way).

A batch Size: 68 students and 2 teachers, because luxury bus having 35 seats \times 2.

Trip Level: Moderately easy. Minimum Age: 13 years.

Reporting Place: At our selected place (to be fixed later).

Trip fees includes: All transportation & Food from Delhi to Camp Site and back to Delhi.

Course Description: Leadership / Adventure Course.

Course Area: Mountain Base Camp at Gourudugh (2200m.) in Hamta Valley.

For the completion of above said program will cost:

- 1. For Adventure & Leadership Course Rs. 8,400/- per child. (Cost includes Lodging, boarding, training & various kinds of equipments for trekking, climbing, and other adventure activities).
- 2. For Travel expenses for going to Manali from Delhi and back by State bus Rs. 1,600/- per child.
- 3. Total Cost Rs. 10,000/- Per Student.
